1. Internal Quality Assurance at Western Balkans University

Quality assurance is the main objective of the Western Balkans University, defined in the institution's vision and mission for a transformative impact on society through continuous innovation in the field of education, scientific research, creativity and entrepreneurship, investing in the preparation of the future professionals prepared for the international labor market, to be an internationally recognized university in the field of scientific research and innovation, with the main goal of continuous improvement of a better life.

The periodic evaluation of the results of the quality of education, research, human resources, finance, infrastructure, public relations, international relations, social and cultural activities, works within the framework of quality development and improvement activities, is a comprehensive, systematic and regular, which institutionalizes the culture of quality at Western Balkans University.

The process of carrying out the questionnaires and drawing up the report on its findings is in accordance with the following legal and by-laws as follows:

- Law No. 80/2015, dated 22.07.2015, "On higher education and scientific research in higher education institutions in the Republic of Albania", Articles 46, 103, 104 and 106
- Quality Code in Higher Education, approved by the Council of Minister Decision (VKM) no. 824, dated on 24.12.2021, "On the approval of the Quality Code of Higher Education"
- European Standards and Guidelines for Quality Assurance in Higher Education
- Statute of Western Balkans University (Articles 37 and 38)
- Basic Regulation of "Western Balkans" University (Article 15)
- Agency for Quality Assurance in Higher Education (ASCAL) manual for the internal quality system.

2. Composition of the Internal Quality Assurance Unit (IQAU-NJSBC) for the academic year 2023-2024

The Internal Quality Assurance Unit (IQAU) consists of 5 (five) members, of which 3 (three) are representatives of the academic staff of the main units, one for each faculty, 1 (one) representative of the Student Council and 1 (one) expert external.

The President and Members of the unit are approved by the Academic Senate on the proposal of the rector.

3. Methodology of the development of the questionnaire process and data processing

During the first semester of the academic year 2024-2025, institutional questionnaires were conducted as part of the assessment of the quality and performance of academic staff in the teaching process. The process of evaluating the quality of teaching by academic staff consists of four (4) components:

- Evaluation from the students,
- Evaluation from colleagues,
- Self-evaluation,
- Evaluation by the head of the department.

At the end of each academic semester, we believe that gathering students' feedback on study programs, specific subjects, lecturers, or particular issues through customized questionnaires directly influences quality assurance within our institution.

The data collected from these questionnaires, once processed, is extensively utilized to support the overall evaluation process. During this process, the heads of the institution assess the academic performance of each lecturer at the end of the academic year and take appropriate measures for improvement.

The questionnaire consists of a standard set of **16 questions**, designed to be measurable and valid, **using a rating scale from 1** (minimum score) to **5** (maximum score). Additionally, a separate section of the questionnaire allows students to provide comments on issues related to the subject and/or the lecturer.

The student questionnaires were completed between June 13 – July 11, 2025, through the SMART platform, ensuring confidentiality and anonymity.

A total of 158 lecturers involved in teaching across 312 different subjects have been evaluated, and a total of 9000 questionnaires have been completed for three faculties, covering 25 study programs, including:

- 18 Bachelor's degree programs,
- 3 Integrated Master of Science programs (Integrated Master of Science in Dentistry, Integrated Master of Science in Medicine, and Integrated Master of Science in Pharmacy), and
- 4 Master of Science (MSc) programs (MSc in Hospital Management, MSc in Nanotechnology, Master of Science in Nursing Profile: Emergency Nursing, and Master of Science in Nursing Profile: Surgical Nursing).
- Out of 158 academic staff evaluated, only 1 (one) was evaluated with less than 3 points, 2 (two) were evaluated in the range 3.00-3.50, and 5 (five) were evaluated in the range 3.51-4.00
- The average rating of the academic staff university-wide was 4.57 out of 5 (maximum score), with a standard deviation of 0.74 (Table 1), indicating a very good evaluation of academic staff by the students.

• More specifically:

Faculty of Economics, Technology and Innovation (FETI):

- A total of 1194 questionnaires were completed by the students covering three departments and 10 study programs, of which 8 (eight) Bachelor's programs (1081 questionnaires) and 2 (two) Master of Sciences programs (103 questionnaires). Specifically:
 - o 168 questionnaires were completed by the students of the **Biotechnology** program (EN),
 - o 152 questionnaires by the students of the program Biomedical Engineering (EN),
 - 278 questionnaires by the students of the program Computer Sciences and Artificial Intelligence (EN),

- o 145 questionnaires by the students of the program Cyber Security (EN),
- o 157 questionnaires by the students of the program **Software Engineering** (EN),
- 21 questionnaires by the students of the program Economics, Data Science and Technology (EN),
- o 47 questionnaires by the students of **Health Care Management** (EN),
- o 72 questionnaires by the students of the program Master of Sciences in Hospital Management (EN),
- o 31 questionnaires by the students of the program Master of Sciences in Nanotechnology (EN),
- Academic staff involved in teaching at FETI were rated with an average of **4.62 points out** of **5 points**, with a standard deviation of 0.934 (Table 2, Graph 1).

Faculty of Medical and Technical Sciences (FSMT):

- A total of 6577 questionnaires were completed by the students, covering four departments and 12 study programs, of which 10 (ten) Bachelor's programs (2813 questionnaires), 2 (two) Master of Sciences study programs (89 questionnaires) and 2 (two) Integrated Second Cycle (Master of Sciences) Programs (3675 questionnaires).
- Specifically:
 - 210 questionnaires were completed by the students of the program Bachelor in Imaging Technician – EN,
 - 230 questionnaires were completed by the students of the program Bachelor in Imaging Technician – AL,
 - 202 questionnaires were completed by the students of the program Bachelor in Laboratory Technician – EN,
 - 170 questionnaires were completed by the students of the program Bachelor in Laboratory Technician – AL,
 - 1163 questionnaires were completed by the students of the program Bachelor in Nursing – EN,
 - 489 questionnaires were completed by the students of the program Bachelor in Nursing – AL,
 - 279 questionnaires were completed by the students of the program Bachelor in Physiotherapy – EN,
 - 70 questionnaires were completed by the students of the program Bachelor in Physiotherapy – AL,
 - o 61 questionnaires were completed by the students of the program Master of Sciences in Nursing Profile: Nursing in Surgery (EN & AL),
 - 143 questionnaires were completed by the students of the program Master of Sciences in Nursing – Profile: Nursing in Emergency (EN & AL),
 - 3610 questionnaires were completed by the students of the program Integrated Second Cycle Program in Medicine – EN,
 - 65 questionnaires were completed by the students of the program Integrated Second Cycle Program in Pharmacy – EN.
- Academic staff involved in teaching at FSMT were rated with an average of **4.59 points** out of **5 points**, with a standard deviation of 0.834 (Table 2, Graph 1).


Faculty of Dental Medicine (FMD):

- A total of 1229questionnaires were completed by students, for one department and three study programs, including 2 (two) Bachelor's programs (163 questionnaires) and 1 (one) Integrated Master program (1066 questionnaires).
- Specifically:
 - 126 questionnaires were completed by the students of the Bachelor in Dental Technician – EN,
 - 63 questionnaires were completed by the students of the Bachelor in Dental Technician – AL,
 - 1066 questionnaires were completed by the students of the Integrated Second Cycle Program in Dentistry – EN.
- Academic staff involved in teaching at FMD were rated with an average of **4.46 points** out of **5 points**, with a standard deviation of 0.834 (Table 2, Graph 1).

4. Evaluation of academic staff by students of the Faculty of Economics, Technology and Innovation (FETI)


4.1. Department of Biosciences and Engineering

The academic staff involved in teaching at the Department of Biosciences and Engineering has been evaluated by students with an average score of **4.58** out of a maximum of 5 points, with a standard deviation of 0.84. Out of **351 completed questionnaires**, the results are as follows:

- 20 students, or 5.7%, rated the academic staff in the range of 1.00–3.00 points,




Graph 2. Evaluation of the academic staff by the students - Department of Biosciences and Engineering




Graph 3. Evaluation of the academic staff performance by the students of *Bachelor in Biomedical Engineering* study program




Graph 4. Evaluation of the academic staff performance by the students of *Bachelor in Biotechnology - EN study program*

Graph 5. Evaluation of the academic staff performance by the students of *Master of Sciences* in *Nanotechnology study program*






Graph 6. Evaluation of the academic staff performance by the students – Department of Computer Sciences




Graph 7. Evaluation of the academic staff performance by the students of *Bachelor in Computer Sciences and Artificial Intelligence* – EN study program




Graph 8. Evaluation of the academic staff performance by the students of *Bachelor in Cyber Security study program*






Graph 10. Evaluation of the academic staff performance by the students – Department of Economic Sciences and Finance




Graph 11. Evaluation of the academic staff performance by the students of *Bachelor in Health Care Management – EN* study program




Graph 12. Evaluation of the academic staff performance by the students of *Bachelor in Economics and Data Science – EN* study program




Graph 13. Evaluation of the academic staff performance by the students of *Bachelor in Business and Technology - EN*








Graph 16. Evaluation of the academic staff performance by the students – Department of Nursing and Physiotherapy




Graph 17. Evaluation of the academic staff performance by the students of *Bachelor in Nursing* study program – English (Nursing – EN)




Graph 18. Evaluation of the academic staff performance by the students of *Bachelor in* Nursing - Albanian study program (Nursing - AL)




Graph 19. Evaluation of the academic staff performance by the students of *Bachelor in Physiotherapy*– English (*Physiotherapy* - *EN*) study program




Graph 20. Evaluation of the academic staff performance by the students of *Bachelor in Physiotherapy* study program – Albanian (*Physiotherapy - AL*)




Graph 21. Evaluation of the academic staff performance by the students of *Master of Sciences in Nursing – Profile: Nursing in Surgery* study program

Graph 22. Evaluation of the academic staff performance by the students of *Master of Sciences in Nursing – Profile: Nursing in Emergency* study program






Graph 23. Evaluation of the academic staff performance by the students – Department of Medical Laboratory Sciences and Imaging

5.2.1. Bachelor in Imaging Technician – English (Imaging Technician - EN)

The academic staff involved in teaching in the *Bachelor in Imaging Technician* – *English (Imaging Technician - EN)* study program has been evaluated by students with an average score of **4.38** out of a maximum of 5 points, with a standard deviation of 1.07. Out of **210** completed questionnaires, the results are as follows:

- 23 students or 10.95% rated the academic staff in the range of 1.00–3.00 points,
- 6 students or 2.86% rated the academic staff in the range of 3.01–3.50 points,
- 27 students or 12.86% rated the academic staff in the range of 3.51–4.00 points,
- 23 students or 10.95% rated the academic staff in the range of 4.01–4.50 points, and
- 131 students or 62.38% rated the academic staff in the range of 4.51–5 points (Table 8, Graph 24).




Graph 24. Evaluation of the academic staff performance by the students of *Bachelor in Imaging Technician – English* study program

- 227 students or 98.7% rated the academic staff in the range of 4.51–5 points (Table 8, Graph 25).




Graph 25. Evaluation of the academic staff performance by the students of *Bachelor in Imaging Technician – Albanian* study program

- 175 students or 86.63% rated the academic staff in the range of 4.51–5 points (Table 8, Graph 26).




Graph 26. Evaluation of the academic staff performance by the students of *Bachelor in Laboratory Technician – English* study program

- 140 students or 82.35% rated the academic staff in the range of 4.51–5 points (Table 8, Graph 27).



- 359 students or 9.94% rated the academic staff in the range of 3.51–4.00 points,
- 172 students or 4.76% rated the academic staff in the range of 4.01–4.50 points, and
- 2701 students or 74.82% rated the academic staff in the range of 4.51–5 points (Table 9, Graph 28).







The academic staff involved in teaching in the *Department of Dentistry* as well as at the Faculty of Dental Medicine (FDM) has been evaluated by students with an average score of **4.46** out of a maximum of 5 points, with a standard deviation of 0.99. Out of **1229** completed questionnaires, the results are as follows:

- 150 students or 12.21% rated the academic staff in the range of 1.00–3.00 points,
- 16 students or 1.3% rated the academic staff in the range of 3.01–3.50 points,
- 123 students or 10.01% rated the academic staff in the range of 3.51–4.00 points,
- 54 students or 4.39% rated the academic staff in the range of 4.01–4.50 points, and
- 886 students or 72.09% rated the academic staff in the range of 4.51–5 points (Table 12, Graph 31).




Graph 31. Evaluation of the academic staff performance by the students - Department of Dentistry and the Faculty of Dental Medicine

- 150 students or 12.21% rated the academic staff in the range of 1.00–3.00 points,
- 6 students or 5.36% rated the academic staff in the range of 3.51–4.00 points,
- 4 students or 3.57% rated the academic staff in the range of 4.01–4.50 points, and
- 99 students or 88.39% rated the academic staff in the range of 4.51–5 points (Table 12, Graph 32).




Graph 32. Evaluation of the academic staff performance by the students of the *Bachelor in Dental Technician – English* study program

6.1.2. Bachelor in Dental Technician – Albanian (Dental Technician - AL)

- 7 students or 13.73% rated the academic staff in the range of 3.51–4.00 points,
- 30 students or 58.82% rated the academic staff in the range of 4.51–5 points (Table 12, Graph 33).




Graph 33. Evaluation of the academic staff performance by the students of the *Bachelor in Dental Technician – Albanian*

6.1.3. Integrated Second Cycle Program in Dentistry

The academic staff involved in teaching in the *Integrated Second Cycle Program in Dentistry* - *EN* study program has been evaluated by students with an average score of **4.49** out of a maximum of 5 points, with a standard deviation of 1.0. Out of **1066** completed questionnaires, the results are as follows:

- 134 students or 12.57% rated the academic staff in the range of 1.00–3.00 points,
- 15 students or 1.41% rated the academic staff in the range of 3.01–3.50 points,
- 110 students or 10.32% rated the academic staff in the range of 3.51–4.00 points,
- 50 students or 4.69% rated the academic staff in the range of 4.01–4.50 points, and
- 757 students or 71.01% rated the academic staff in the range of 4.51–5 points (Table 12, Graph 34).

7. Comparison of the academic staff evaluation by students between faculties and at the university level

To make a summary comparison:

The academic staff involved in teaching at the Faculty of Economy, Technology, and Innovation has been evaluated by students with an average score of 4.51 out of 5 points, with a standard deviation of 0.934. Out of 1194 completed questionnaires, the results are as follows:

- 119 students or 9.97% rated the academic staff in the range of 1.00–3.00 points,
- 28 students or 2.35% rated them in the range of 3.01–3.50 points,
- 100 students or 8.38% rated them in the range of 3.51–4.00 points,
- 70 students or 5.86% rated them in the range of 4.01–4.50 points,
- 877 students or 73.45% rated them in the range of 4.51–5 points.

The academic staff involved in teaching at the Faculty of Technical Medical Sciences has been evaluated by students with an average score of 4.59 out of 5 points, with a standard deviation of 0.804. Out of 6577 completed questionnaires, the results are:

- 624 students or 9.49% rated the academic staff in the range of 1.00–3.00 points,
- 213 students or 2.24% in the range of 3.01–3.50 points,
- 709 students or 10.78% in the range of 3.51–4.00 points,
- 343 students or 5.22% in the range of 4.01–4.50 points,
- 4,688 students or 71.28% in the range of 4.51–5 points.

The academic staff involved in teaching at the **Faculty of Dental Medicine** has been evaluated by students with an **average score of 4.46 out of 5 points**, with a **standard deviation of 0.99**. Out of **1,229 completed questionnaires**, the results are:

- 150 students or 12.21% rated the staff in the range of 1.00–3.00 points,

- 16 students or 1.3% in the range of 3.01–3.50 points,
- 123 students or 10.01% in the range of 3.51–4.00 points,
- 54 students or 4.39% in the range of 4.01–4.50 points,
- 886 students or 72.09% in the range of 4.51–5 points.


At the university level:

A total of 9,000 questionnaires were completed, and 158 lecturers involved in teaching across 312 different courses (Appendix 2), within 25 study programs and 3 different faculties, were evaluated with an average score of 4.54 out of 5.00, and a standard deviation of 0.9. From the anonymously completed questionnaires, the results are:

- 833 students or 9.92% rated the academic staff in the range of 1.00–3.00 points,
- 257 students or 2.86% in the range of 3.01–3.50 points,
- 932 students or 10.36% in the range of 3.51–4.00 points,
- 467 students or 5.19% in the range of 4.01–4.50 points,
- 6,451 students or 71.68% in the range of 4.51–5 points.
- In total, **6,918 students or 76.87%** of the respondents rated the academic staff **very positively**, in the range of 4.01–5 points.
- It is also concluded that there is **no significant difference between faculties** in terms of rating levels (Table 13, Graph 35).

8. Conclusions

The 2024–2025 academic year marks the third year of operation for Western Balkans University. Based on the results of student evaluations of the academic staff and the teaching process — conducted anonymously through online questionnaires — it was found that the academic staff involved in teaching at Western Balkans University demonstrated a strong commitment to the effective implementation of the teaching process. This is also reflected in the students' evaluations. There was observed, a more or less similar distribution of student evaluation levels (%) across the faculties.

At the institutional level:

- 9.92% of students rated the academic staff in the range of 1.00-3.00 points,
- 2.86% of students rated the academic staff in the range of 3.00–3.50 points,
- 10.36% of students rated the academic staff in the range of 3.51–4.00 points,
- 5.19% of students rated the academic staff in the range of 4.01–4.50 points,
- 71.68% of students rated the academic staff in the range of 4.51–5 points.
- In total, the majority of students —76.87%— rated the academic staff above 4.01 points out of a maximum of 5, with a percentage approximately 3% higher in the Faculty of Economy, Technology, and Innovation compared to the other two faculties.

At the Faculty of Economy, Technology, and Innovation (FETI):

- 9.97% of students rated the academic staff in the range of 1.00–3.00 points,
- 2.35% of students rated the academic staff in the range of 3.01–3.50 points,
- 8.38% of students rated the academic staff in the range of 3.51–4.00 points,
- 5.86% of students rated the academic staff in the range of 4.01–4.50 points,
- 73.45% of students rated the academic staff in the range of 4.51–5 points.
- In total, the majority of students **79.31%** rated the academic staff above 4.01 points out of a maximum of 5.

At the Faculty of Technical Medical Sciences:

- 9.49% of students rated the academic staff in the range of 1.00–3.00 points,
- 2.24% of students rated the academic staff in the range of 3.01–3.50 points,
- 10.78% of students rated the academic staff in the range of 3.51–4.00 points,
- 5.22% of students rated the academic staff in the range of 4.01–4.50 points,
- 71.28% of students rated the academic staff in the range of 4.51–5 points.
- In total, the majority of students **79.50%** rated the academic staff above 4.01 points out of a maximum of 5.

At the Faculty of Dental Medicine:

- 12.21% of students rated the academic staff in the range of 1.00–3.00 points,
- 1.3% of students rated the academic staff in the range of 3.01–3.50 points,
- 10.01% of students rated the academic staff in the range of 3.51–4.00 points,
- 4.39% of students rated the academic staff in the range of 4.01–4.50 points,
- 72.09% of students rated the academic staff in the range of 4.51–5 points.
- In total, the majority of students **76.48%** rated the academic staff above 4.01 points out of a maximum of 5.


9. Recommendations

The report will be presented to the collegial bodies of WBU and will be published on the website of the institution's Internal Quality Assurance Unit to ensure access to the information and its use in the best interest of improving institutional academic performance and increasing transparency with students and the interested public.
